Note: This table presents unduplicated counts of individuals and households who experienced homelessness and received services from emergency and transitional shelters in the 2014 fiscal year. ¹The Compact of Free Association citizens are the citizens of the Federated States of Micronesia, the Republic of the Marshall Islands, or the Republic of Palau. ² Chronic Homelessness is defined as someone with a disabling condition who has been homeless continuously for a year or more, or had at least four episodes of homelessness in the past three years. Examples of disabling conditions include: a diagnosable substance abuse disorder, HIV/AIDS, or a disability as defined in the Social Security Act. ³ Prior Residence refers to the place where a household lived and slept most of the time prior to entering the program. Unsheltered refers to individuals living outdoors or in places not intended for human habitation, such as a park or the beach. Sheltered settings include emergency or transitional shelters, mental health and medical hospitals, prisons, substance abuse facilities, and the YMCA. Doubled up refers to individuals living in a family member's or friend's room, apartment, or house.
